Assesses your skills in:

Language comprehension test

Multiple choice	Duration	Number	Pass mark
Language 3	25 minutes	12 questions	6/12

- Reading skills, vocabulary, grammar, appropriate language use
- Based only on the information in the text no extra knowledge



Translation test

Duration	Languages	Pass mark
60 minutes	From language 2 to language 1	50/100

- Scored only for candidates who pass **and** score the highest on the language tests
- Pass/fail (must reach pass mark)



Revision test

Duration	Languages	Pass mark
30 minutes	From language 2 to language 1	20/40

- Only scored for candidates who pass the translation test
- Passing required to move to the next phase



OVERALL SCORING

Candidates who pass the revision test will have their overall score calculated.

The overall score (maximum 152) is the sum of:

Language comprehension test (max 12 points)

Translation test (max 100 points)

Revision test (max 40 points)




